## BAC BENEVOLENT FUND

With reference to your application to the benevolent Fund please read these notes carefully as they give an outline of the scope and purpose of this fund.

The monies used to provide payments from this fund are raised from commercial sponsorship, donations and a percentage of BAC members subscriptions.

The BAC intends to continue these grants for as long as it is possible and aims to treat all people who ask for a grant, equally. As the Fund is not large enough to make grants solely from the interest on the money deposited, grants will only be made up to a maximum amount decided upon by the BAC Executive Committee under recommendation from the Trustees. At any time the amount can be increased or decreased depending upon the financial position of the Fund.

Grants are given primarily to those athletes who have had to retire from their sport, and are suffering financial hardship as a result of a career ending injury that was not covered by insurance, or where any such insurance is inadequate. Other donations may be awarded on the grounds of extreme hardship brought on by other factors, and each case will be treated on individual merit.

For the purpose of the Fund the BAC and Sports Aid define hardship as the possibility of losing one's home due to rent or mortgage arrears, having the bailiffs sent in, or some other equally serious financial problem.

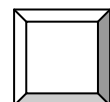
The fund cannot pay for private medical insurance premiums and cannot pay for the costs involved in nursing or residential care. Nor can it provide money to set up businesses or provide for holidays. It cannot make loans to BAC members nor pay court fines or fund legal cases unless deemed by the Trustees to have implications for the wider benefit of elite athletes in general.

We intend to make payments wherever possible direct to the creditor and would always expect any grant to be used for the purpose it was asked for and given. Before any grant can be made a Benevolent Fund application form must be completed.

All grants are made at the discretion of the Trustees of the BAC Benevolent Fund.
