Where have we helped?

Taxation – In partnership with Granite Morgan Smith accountants, The BAC have been negotiating the tax position held by the government relating to your UK Sport APA which has now resulted in a beneficial outcome for you. For more information go to our website at www.britishathletes.org

Anti-Doping – With the introduction of the Athlete Whereabouts system and the change in the amount of information you as an athlete need to supply, there are bound to be mishaps and we have been instrumental in offering advice on what to do if things do go wrong. With links into UK Sport and WADA we will carry on supporting the needs and thoughts of GB athletes.

Mediation - The BAC can act as mediator when relations have broken down in a sport between athletes and team management. We provide a confidential advice service for athletes who have problems and do not know who to go to for advice.



How about making some money?

“athletesDirect” links athletes to schools that would like a visit. There are over 20,000 schools in Britain and currently less than 500 official athlete visits annually. Once linked Athletes and schools have full control and liaise to arrange the visit and negotiate a small fee of up to £300. (3 visit references required to join)

How will we carry on?

As with every other sporting organisation in the UK, the BAC has needed to change to be run as a business to survive. Grants are reducing and costs are getting higher, but we still need to be here to represent you.
